OVERVIEW

KMnet Admin is the second major release for Kyocera Mita's Java-based device management program. It is primarily a performance release and offers greatly improved speed and lower memory usage, as well as some new and enhanced features.

System Improvements (from 1.01c to 2.0)

- Memory usage 30% decrease
- Open Device Property Page 75% decrease
- First Starting Time for server- 76% decrease (1.01c 420sec, 2.0 100sec)
- Later Times Starting Time for server 72% decrease (1.01c 240sec, 2.0 66sec)
- Hard Disk Space 47% decrease
- Package Size (Full) 24% decrease
- Package Size (Light1) 49% decrease

SUPPORT FOR ADDITIONAL NETWORK PROTOCOLS


KMnet Admin 2.0 newly supports IPv6 and SNMPv3 for applicable Kyocera devices.

ADDING MULTIPLE DEVICES BY IP ADDRESSES OR HOSTNAMES

KMnet Admin 2.0 lets administrators add multiple devices by IP address or host name in one step by entering or pasting them into the discovery target list. This is especially helpful if administrators do not want to perform network discovery, but instead add known IP addresses or host names stored in another format.

¹ Light package will be used for incremental upgrades after the 2.0 release. It does not include Java and other common libraries.





NEW REPORTS AND COUNTERS

KMnet Admin 2.0 adds a number of additional reports that have been requested since the 1.0 release. These new reports include:

- Device Volume by Manufacturer
- Device Usage by Accounts
- Device Counters Raw Data Export
- Account Report
- Account Activity on Devices

KMnet Admin Accounting Manager now also supports the following counters and restrictions for applicable devices:

- Hagaki
- Fax-in counters
- Fax-in function restriction
- Copier and scan function restriction
- Fax send time restriction



EXPORT OF RAW ACCOUNTING DATA

Users can now export accounting counter data as CSV and XML files in addition to creating HTML and PDF reports.

ACCOUNT GROUPING

For more efficient accounting management, users can now create groups of printing devices or accounts that have similar properties. Once groups are created, users can manage printing devices and accounts by group. Reports can be generated based on a specified group.


Note: Creating a group for one printing device lets users create a report based on that device.

ACCOUNT MULTI-SET AND CLONING

Account Multi-set and Clone lets administrators set up accounts and account settings on multiple devices or copy accounts from a source to a destination device.

Note: Kyocera printers and MFPs have accounts stored separately for every device even if they have the same account ID. Cloning many accounts to many devices, or using Multi-set for large numbers of accounts or devices will increase the KMnet Admin database size and adversely affect performance. For example, cloning 50 accounts to 20 devices will create 1000 account records in the KMnet Admin database.

For any operation that will result in more than 1000 accounting record, a warning will be displayed.






The multi-set accounting wizard allows administrators to edit the following settings on all selected devices.

Overall device settings:

- Accounting Control
- Security Mode
- Anonymous Access
- Accounting Mode
- Balance Pattern
- Cancel on Balance Error
- Cancel on Account Error
- Error Report Output
- Reset Counters Schedule

Per account settings (these settings will be applied to all accounts on the selected device):

- Account Balances (applied for all accounting counters)
- Balance Restrictions
- Function Restrictions



When running multi-set for accounting, additional accounts can be added from the KMnet Admin database. These accounts will be copied to the device with the settings specified in multi-set.



MINOR CHANGES

The new quick search feature for Accounting Manager lets users find accounts and account groups by Account Name, Sub Name, and Account Code.

- Minimum configuration for running KMnet Admin: 512MB memory, 500MB hard disk space
- Recommended configuration for small to medium networks, or when using plug-in consoles like Print Job Manager and/or Accounting: 2.0 GHz CPU, 1GB memory, 500MB hard disk space
- Recommended configuration for enterprise networks: 2.0 GHz CPU, 2GB memory, 2GB hard disk space

DEVICE MANAGER MAXIMUM VALIDATED CONFIGURATION:

Up to 1500 managed devices, 45 managed networks, 100 device groups, and 10 simultaneous client connections

ACCOUNTING MANAGER MAXIMUM VALIDATED CONFIGURATION:

Up to 1000 managed device accounts

PRINT JOB MANAGER MAXIMUM VALIDATED CONFIGURATION:

Up to 2000 print jobs per day

MY PRINT JOBS MAXIMUM VALIDATED CONFIGURATION:

Up to 100 simultaneous user connections
