# Introduction




This document explains the Fiery Automation Package features and how they work.

The Fiery Automation Package for the Kyocera® Printing System 17 Powered by Fiery® offers additional production features for operators (or users with Operator or Administrator privileges) to monitor and manage the print workflow of jobs on the Kyocera® Printing System 17 Powered by Fiery®.

**Note:** The Fiery Automation Package requires Fiery system software FS400 and later to be installed on the Kyocera® Printing System 17 Powered by Fiery®.

## Fiery Automation Package

The Fiery Automation Package provides a convenient access to automation and advanced job management functions to the PS-17. Fiery Automation Package is installed on Command WorkStation, and activated from Command WorkStation and WebTools. The Fiery Automation Package features are accessible from Command WorkStation, Fiery Hot Folders, and the printer driver.

The production features include:

## Feature activation

The Fiery Automation Package options must be activated at the PS-17 before you can access its features from your computer. An administrator or service technician activates the option at your site using the software licensing feature in Command WorkStation or in WebTools.

The Fiery Automation Package is an option for the PS-17.

### Check activation status

- To check if an optional feature is activated at the PS-17, do one of the following:
  - Print the Configuration page (see *Configuration and Setup*).
  - In Command WorkStation Device Center, check the General Info tab.
  - In Command WorkStation Device Center, click General > Server Configuration, click RIP and check the list of installed options in the BIOS Setup section.
  - In WebTools, click Manage.

### Update the status for an installed option on your computer

If an optional feature is activated at the PS-17, you must update the status of the option on your computer before you can access the feature from your computer.

### Check the status for an installed option in Command WorkStation

- 1 Open Device Center in one of the following ways:
  - Click the More icon (three vertical dots) next to the server name in the Servers pane.
  - Double-click the server name in the Servers pane.
  - Click Server > Device Center.
  - Right-click the server name and select Device Center.
- 2 Click General > General Info.
- 3 Verify that the feature appears under Options/Packages.

- 4 If the feature is not shown, in the Options/Packages area, click Manage.

You will need the License Activation Code (LAC) that is provided with the PS-17 to activate the feature. For detailed instructions, click "?" on the Manage Fiery Options page.

### **Check the status for an installed option in WebTools**

- 1 Open an Internet browser and type the IP address of the PS-17.
- 2 In WebTools, click the Home tab and verify that the feature appears under Installed Options.
- 3 If the feature is not shown, under Installed Options, click Manage.

You will need the License Activation Code (LAC) that is provided with the PS-17 to activate the feature. For detailed instructions, click "?" on the Manage Fiery Options page.



# Advanced job management features

The following sections describe how to access and use some of the advanced job management features.

## Print Next

The Print Next feature moves the selected job immediately to the Printing queue. If another job is currently printing, the selected job for Print Next is printed immediately after.

**Note:** The Print Next feature is valid for jobs that have spooled to the PS-17, but have not yet been sent to the printer. If you want a job that has already been sent to the printer to print next, you must specify that job from the printer control panel. For more information, see the documentation that accompanies your printer.

## Process Next

The Process Next feature moves the selected job next to the currently processing job, bypassing other jobs in the Processing queue.

The feature is accessed from the Actions menu of the Processing queue in Command WorkStation.

## Schedule printing

The Schedule printing feature allows you to set a specific date and time for printing a job.

The Schedule printing print option is accessible from the Job Info tab in both the Job Properties window in Command WorkStation and the printer driver. Select the check box in the Destination area. The job is printed based on the date and time set on the PS-17, not the client computer.

If multiple jobs are selected and defined with the same date and time setting, job order is based on the alphabetical order of the file names.

**Note:** This option is invalid if your job is sent to the Direct connection.
